About the Midnight Memory Walk

Ladies join us on a girl's night out with a difference! The Midnight Memory Walk is a seven mile sponsored walk from Ashton Gate Stadium, Bristol on Friday, 4 September 2009. The circular route takes in some of the greatest sights of Bristol including the Clifton Suspension Bridge, SS Great Britain and Millennium Square.

The event is open to ladies only and the minimum age is 16. Parental consent is required for 16 - 18 year olds. The route is suitable for wheelchairs but unsuitable for dogs except guide dogs.

Entry is just £12 and includes a t-shirt, goodies on the night, medal, one candle bag, fundraising pack and light breakfast.
