* Ideas and tips to maximise your fundraising

There is no minimum sponsorship amount to take part, but we suggest raising at least £100. Below are some fun ideas to get you started:

- Ask family and friends to sponsor you via your online fundraising page
- Spread the word and ask for sponsorship on social media using your progress sharing graphics available to download at www.chsw.org.uk/june100k
- Invite friends and family to sign up and join in with your fundraising
- O Host a quiz or bingo and ask for donations to take part
- Get baking and have a cookie and cake sale
- Organise a raffle or tombola
- Hold a dress down day at your workplace or school in return for a donation
- Always have your sponsor form ready so you don't miss any donations.

Put your best foot forward to help raise vital funds to make the most of short and precious lives. Your wonderful support will help provide essential care for those who need it most.

The challenge starts on Sunday 1 June and ends on Monday 30 June so plan your runs around a pace and distance that suits you. Your distance tracker will help you keep record of your progress.

To say thank you, once you have completed the challenge, we will send you a medal and certificate.

Cash donations. Use the sponsor form included, collect cash and pay in donations online or by sending a cheque in the post. Gift Aid can be added too!!


