£100...

## Before the event

- ☺ Chat to your team to set a date and location, your Breakfast with Santa could be part of a team meeting in the office, or a festive end of year thank you to the team
- ☺ Nominate your Santa
- ☺ Check dietary requirements
- ☺ Encourage staff to wear something festive
- ☺ Could your business match fund or round up your donation after the event?
- ☺ Share on social media that you're holding a festive breakfast and encourage other companies such as clients, suppliers and partners to do the same.

- ☺ Take photos and share on social media, making sure you tag CHSW
- ☺ Suggest a minimum donation of £5 per person, collection options are listed below
- ☺ Prizes for best festive dressed

## How to collect donations

**Fundraise online.** Simple to set up and means you have no money to collect! Sponsors can add Gift Aid (an extra 25p for every £1 donated). Set up an online giving page on Facebook, or at [www.justgiving.com](http://www.justgiving.com)

**Contactless donations.** CharityGo mobile app turns your smart phone into a card reader to take safe and secure donations from credit and debit cards as well as digital wallets, such as Apple Pay, Google Pay and Samsung Pay. 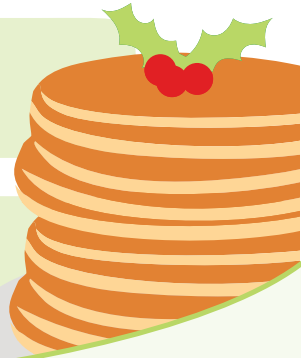

## To assemble the bunting

- ☺ Cut along the solid black line so you have 2 diamond shapes
- ☺ Fold each diamond along the dashed line to make a double sided bunting flag
- ☺ Thread the bunting string/fabric under the fold and glue the 2 bunting flags together
- ☺ Repeat this process until your bunting is as long as you require

**Top tip:** alternate the bunting flags so you have 4 different designs on each side!
