Ideas and tips to maximise your fundraising

We are asking each person who takes part to pledge to raise £60 in memory of those they are walking for. Below are some ideas to get you started:

- ☺ Ask family and friends to sponsor you via your online fundraising page
- ☺ Spread the word and ask for sponsorship on social media using the sharing graphic available to download at chsw.org.uk/moonlight and #CHSWMoonlight
- ☺ Invite friends and family to sign up and take part in Moonlight Memory Walk with you and fundraise together
- ☺ Host a quiz or bingo and ask for donations to take part
- ☺ Get baking and have a cookie and cake sale
- ☺ Organise a raffle or tombola
- ☺ Hold a dress down day at your workplace in return for a donation
- ☺ Always have your sponsor form ready so you don't miss any donations
- ☺ Advertise your fundraising events using the enclosed poster template
- ☺ Share ideas and photos in the Facebook event.

As you walk in memory of your loved ones, your wonderful support will help to provide essential care for those who need it most. We look forward to welcoming you to this uplifting evening.

A special feature is the Moonlight Memory Walk dedication page where you, your family and your friends, can add your loved one's name, photo and a personal message which will feature in the memory ceremony.

The evening starts with a special memory ceremony where we celebrate and remember your loved ones. Lit paths will then guide your way on a 4k walk with special points along the way to pause and remember by completing activities in your loved one's memory.

On the evening you will collect your purple memory walk T-shirt and you are welcome to get creative with your outfits:

- ☺ Add battery operated lights to your outfit and items like umbrellas or walking sticks
- ☺ Wear purple themed fancy dress or hair braids.
