

Celyn is 12 years old and was diagnosed at birth with a range of disabilities. Celyn and her dad visit Charlton Farm hospice near Bristol for respite breaks. Her dad, Mark tells us how the hospice help to enhance Celyn's experiences and have some fun!

“Celyn's time at the hospice has broadened her horizons with unique experiences, from cooking and day trips to the beach or local sites, to visits from musicians, firemen and various animals.

Celyn, like many children who have endured dozens of operations and procedures, is scared of hospitals, nurses and doctors. It is an enormous comfort knowing that if her condition deteriorates the hospice will be there for us and that she would be able to be looked after in a place she associates with fun, kindness and positive new experiences.

Celyn is now in her first year of secondary school and the hospice has been a constant good thing in her life, somewhere to talk about and look forward to. Our visits there and the support we receive have had such a positive impact on our whole family.”
