How do we use your money?

The much needed support we offer is wide ranging and is available for the whole family; mums, dads, brothers and sisters. From short respite breaks, sibling support, emergency and palliative care, to end of life and bereavement care. The average time a family uses our services is eight years, and even after the child dies we are here for as long as the family needs us. We are available 24/7, 365 days a year.

£10

will pay for paints and materials for children and siblings to enjoy art therapy.

£25

will help to pay for medical consumables for a day at one of our hospices.

£100

could pay the food bill for one day at one of our hospices.

£200

will help to fund 24 hour doctor cover for one day.

£1,000

could fund heat, power and light for one week at one of our hospices.
