Thank you for signing up for the Plymouth Half. Together we will raise awareness and vital funds for children and young people living with life-limiting conditions and their families across the South West. We ask our runners to each raise £100.

£100...

could help provide a parent with an uninterrupted nights sleep, to give them the strength to face tomorrow.

£150...

could pay for compassionate and intensive support for families in the days following the death of their child.

£320...

could pay for a day of support and care in the family home for a child, young person and their family.





Ideas and tips to maximise your fundraising

We are asking participants to raise a suggested minimum of ± 100 for local children, young people and their families. Below are some fun ideas to get you started.

- Ask family and friends to sponsor you via your online fundraising page
- Spread the word and ask for sponsorship on social media using the sharing graphic available to download at www.chsw.org.uk/plymouthhalf and hashtag #CHSWPlymouthHalf
- Invite friends and family to sign up and join your running team
- Hold an in-person or virtual quiz and ask for donations to take part
- ③ Get baking and have a cookie and cake sale
- I Hold an in-person or virtual bingo and ask for donations to take part
- I Hold a supermarket collection day on a running machine
- Organise a raffle or tombola
- I Hold a dress down day at your workplace in return for a donation
- O Always have your sponsor form ready so you don't miss any donations
- Advertising your fundraising events using the enclosed poster template.


